Archbishop Collins has asked that this weekend (June 5-6) be designated as Catholic Education "Sign Up Sunday" in all parishes. We invite all parishioners to designate their support of the Catholic school system on their property tax assessment. Our parish lies within the boundaries of **Toronto Catholic District School Board**. You may not be aware that if you move, your assessment status defaults to that of a public ratepayer. Your support helps to maintain an accurate registry of Catholic ratepayers, determine the number of Catholic Trustees to govern our schools, and most importantly, allows you to participate in the voting process to elect School Board Trustees. The next election will take place this October in municipalities throughout our Archdiocese.
