### Community Meeting

WHAT: Community consultation meeting re: cycling infrastructure and conditions

WHEN: Tuesday June 22, 6-8pm

WHERE: Deer Park Library (40 St. Clair Ave East, just east of Yonge).

This meeting has been organized to discuss the various problems faced by cyclists in Midtown Toronto, and plan strategies for how best to address them. The ward contains a number of major cycling routes and destinations, and an increasing number of residents in the ward are cycling to work, on errands and for recreation. Unfortunately, cycling facilities in many parts of the ward are nonexistent or unmaintained, and we are conducting an audit and survey to determine the areas in most need of improvement, including cycling infrastructure, road conditions, enforcement and safety. Representatives from the City and the Cyclists Union will also be present to answer questions. All residents of the area are welcome to attend.
